Eggplant: Italian – Nadia	Glossy, black, large fruits
Eggplant: Asian - Orient Express	Slender, 8-10 inch, glossy
Horseradish	Hardy perennial grown for its roots
Kale: Dinosaur	Long, narrow leaves
Kale: Starbor	Finely curled, compact
Pepper: Red Knight	Large bell, sweet, thick-walled, blocky
Pepper: Carmen	Italian sweet, large, long and pointed
Pepper: Lunchbox	Sweet flavorful snack size, (red, yellow, & orange)
Pepper: Islander	Medium purple bell, thick-walled, mild sweet flavor
Pepper: Jalapeno	Jalafuego variety, large 3-4 inch, dark green, hot
Pepper: Habanero	Extremely hot with citrus flavor, approx 2 inch fruits
Swiss Chard: Bright Lights	Multiple colors, bolt-resistant
Tomato: Cherry – Sakura	Prolific, compact plant, good disease resistance
Tomato: Cherry – Sun Gold	Sweet, fruity flavor, orange in color
Tomato: Cherry - Mexico Midget	Prolific, ½ – ¾ inch fruits, dark red, flavorful
Tomato : Cherry – Sweetie	Very sweet, bite sized
Tomato: Plum - Amish Paste	Heirloom, 8-12 oz, ideal for canning/sauces or slicing
Tomato: Slicing – Brandywine	Heirloom, large, flavorful, smooth flesh, can be > 1 lb
Tomato: Slicing - Big Beef	Full-flavored, 10-12 oz. fruit, some disease resistance
Tomato: Slicing – Carbon	Heirloom, black variety, rich flavor, meaty flesh, 10-14 oz.
Tomato:Slicing-Cherokee Purple	Heirloom, rich flavor and texture, medium to large
